<b>LG - Grader</b>	
Overview	Participants will gain a sound understanding of the Grader operations and responsibilities. The Grader assessment is conducted through a combination of practical demonstration, verbal questioning and written testing and calculations, and the ability to perform tasks to the National Occupational Health & Safety Standard and Worksafe Victoria Standards.
