<p>Overview</p>	<p>Participants will gain a sound understanding of the Boom Type Elevated Wok Platform to operate over 11 metres. The Boom Type Elevated Wok Platform assessment is conducted through a combination of practical demonstration, verbal questioning and written testing and calculations, and the ability to perform tasks to the National Occupational Health & Safety Standard and Worksafe Victoria Standards.</p>
