<h3>Non-Slewing Crane &gt; 3 Tonnes</h3>	
<p>Overview</p>	<p>Participants will gain a sound understanding of a non-slewing crane greater than 3 tonnes. The non-slewing crane greater than 3 tonnes assessment is conducted through a combination of practical demonstration, verbal questioning and written testing and calculations, and the ability to perform tasks to the National Occupational Health &amp; Safety Standard and Worksafe Victoria Standards.</p>
<p>Duration</p>	<p>2 days (experienced operators) 5 days (no experience) Standard duration is 5 days however this can be tailored to suit in specific circumstances</p>
