Forklift Truck - LF	
Overview	Participants will gain a sound understanding of the Forklift Truck and competencies. The Forklift Truck assessment is conducted through a combination of practical demonstration, verbal questioning and written testing and calculations, and the ability to perform tasks to the National Occupational Health & Safety Standard and Worksafe Victoria Standards.
Duration	1-day course 7am to 2pm for experienced operators. Pre-requisite Log Book or Record of Experience minimum hours of experience 40 hours. 2-day course for inexperienced operators 7am to 2pm daily Standard duration is 2 days however this can be tailed to suit in specific circumstances
