

Slewing Crane (C2)	
Overview	Participants will gain a sound understanding of the slewing mobile crane up to 20 tonnes operations and responsibilities. The assessment is conducted through a combination of practical demonstration, verbal questioning and written testing and calculations, and the ability to perform tasks to the National Occupational Health & Safety Standard and Worksafe Victoria Standards.
Duration	2 days (experienced operators) 5 days (no experience) Standard duration is 5 days however this can be tailed to suit in specific circumstances
